

## Attending Church

The following is based on the current government and Church of Scotland guidance, so is subject to change.

- If you have any COVID-19 symptoms, you must not attend church.
- Please arrive at church in good time.
- You are required to wear a mask, except where an exemption applies. (see Government guidance).
- A steward will take your name and contact details on arrival (as required for “trace and protect”).
- Please observe social distancing guidelines, currently 1 m apart. No hand shaking or hugs.
- Please use hand sanitiser on arrival and when leaving. (Automatic dispensers are provided containing Cleenol Medisan 70% hand sanitising gel).
- The offering can be left in the plate at the entrance.
- You will be instructed where to sit. Family members can sit together.
- Singing will be allowed when indicated, but you must still keep your mask on.
- The doors will be left open to ensure ventilation, so dress appropriately.
- If you become unwell during the service, please raise your hand. Do not leave your seat. A steward will attend to you.
- Please remain in your seat at the end of the service until a steward advises you to leave.
- Please do not gather outside the church but disperse to enable the church to be emptied as quickly as possible.

In addition, anyone classified as vulnerable or extremely vulnerable should follow the latest Government guidance.
